

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON PORTFOLIO EXPENDITURES

General Fund

The General Fund is essentially made up of the expenditure of government departments and bodies under the authority of a minister and whose budget is funded through appropriations allocated by the National Assembly.

Special funds are entities set up by law to finance certain activities within government departments and bodies.

The activities of special funds are financed mainly through tax revenues, duties and permits as well as transfers from program spending.

Bodies in the health and social services network

Bodies in the health and social services network include integrated health and social services centres as well as other public institutions and regional authorities. These bodies provide the public with general and specialized health services.

The activities of the health and social services network are funded primarily through transfers from program spending, plus, in particular, the sale of goods and services, such as the contribution of adults residing in CHSLDs or parking revenues.

Bodies in the education networks

Bodies in the education networks consist of school boards,¹ the Comité de gestion de la taxe scolaire de l'île de Montréal, CEGEPs and the Université du Québec and its constituents. These bodies offer preschool, elementary, secondary, college and university educational services.

The activities of the education networks are financed mainly through transfers from program spending, plus, in particular, the school property tax and tuition fees.

Tax-funded expenditures

Tax-funded expenditures include refundable tax credits granted under the personal and corporate tax systems as well as expenditures related to doubtful tax accounts.

Refundable tax credits are transfers made through the tax system and they are reclassified and presented as such in government spending.
